



April Square

Finished Measurements

Approximately 11" x 11", depending on gauge

Materials

Any worsted weight yarn that gets between 4-5 sts/inch

US size 7-9, depending on gauge

Pattern Notes

K: Knit

P: Purl

Sl: Slip as many as indicated as if to purl, with working yarn as indicated

PW3: Purl, with wrapping the yarn three times. On the next row, slip the stitch, dropping the extra wraps off the needle.

A: Color A

B: Color B

Pattern is in multiples of 10 + 8; could easily be adapted to be wider by adding stitches in sets of ten.

Instructions

Cast on 48

Knit three rows

Row 1 (rs): Using A, knit across

Row 2 (ws): Using A, k3, p42, k3

Row 3 (rs): Using A, as row 1

Row 4 (ws): Using A, k3, [pw3 (twice), p8] four times, pw3 (twice), k3

Row 5 (rs): Using B, k3, [s2, k8] four times, s2, k3 (drop extra wraps off the needle when slipping sts)

Row 6 (ws): Using B, as row 5 (move your yarn to the front when slipping stitches)

Row 7 (rs): Using B, k3, [sl 2, p8] four times, s2, k3 (move your yarn to the back when slipping stitches)

Row 8 (ws): Using B, as row 5 (move your yarn to the front when slipping stitches)

Repeat the above eight rows seven times, for a total of eight repeats

With color A, repeat rows 1-3

Knit three rows

Bind off

Finishing

Weave in ends; block
