

June Square

Finished Measurements

Approximately 11" x 11", depending on gauge

Materials

Any worsted weight yarn that gets between 4-5 sts/inch
US size 7-9, depending on gauge

Pattern Notes

K: Knit

P: Purl

S1: with yarn in back, slip one as if to purl

It is recommended, although of course not required, that Color A be a solid color, and Color B variegated.

Should you wish to make your square wider, add to your cast-on number in multiples of two.

Instructions

With Color A, cast on 50

Knit three rows

Row 1: With Color A - knit

Row 2: With Color A - k3, p44, k3

Row 3: With Color B - k3, *s1, k1; rep from * until there are 3 sts left; k3

Row 4: With Color B - k3, p44, k3

Row 5: With Color A - k3, *k1, s1; rep from * until there are 3 sts left; k3

Row 6: With Color A - k3, p44, k3

Repeat rows 3 through 6 sixteen times, or until you have a square piece (your number of repeats may vary depending on your row gauge).

With Color A, knit four rows

Bind off

Finishing

Weave in ends; block
