

2009: The Year of the Afghan - October Square

Finished Measurements

Approximately 11" x 11",
depending on gauge



Materials

Any worsted weight yarn that
gets between 4-5 sts/inch
US size 7-9, depending on
gauge

Pattern Notes

This pattern is only charted. Do
not be afraid! Charts are not as
scary as you might think.

Below is the legend, which is
also posted directly under the pattern chart:

□	Knit on right side; purl on wrong side
●	Purl on right side; knit on wrong side
†	Knit through the back loop
	Cable 6 front - Slip 3 sts onto DPN, hold in front; knit 3, knit 3 from DPN
	
	Cable 6 back - Slip 3 sts onto DPN, hold in back; knit 3, knit 3 from DPN

DPN = Double Pointed Needle; commonly used in place of a cable needle. Feel free to substitute a cable needle, or even to cable without a cable needle if you are comfortable with that.

Instructions

Cast on 53

Knit three rows

Follow the chart below; remember that right-side rows are read right to left; wrong-side rows are read left to right.

Repeat chart six times; but as your row gauge may vary-- feel free to stop after completing any right-side row that gives you a length half an inch shorter than the width of your square, even if you have done less than (or more than) the given number of chart repeats.

Knit three rows

Bind off

Finishing

Weave in ends; block
