

August is for Jack

Size:

One

Finished Measurements:

4" x 74"

Materials:

Two skeins of Malabrigo Silky wool (shown in Matisse Blue [color A] and Camote [color B])

A pair of US 4 needles

Pattern Notes:

This pattern could easily be adapted into a wider scarf by adding to the cast-on number in multiples of 8, or by using a thicker yarn and a larger needle.

A: Color A (for the sample scarf, Matisse Blue)

B: Color B (for the sample scarf, Camote)

K: Knit

P: Purl

S1: Slip one as if to purl

KW: Knit as normal, but wrap the yarn twice rather than once; on the next row back, when slipping the stitch, be sure to slip once and drop the extra wrap off the needle. This gives the slipped stitch extra length to compensate for being slipped four times.

Instructions:

Using A, cast on 30

Set up for pattern: Using A, do four rows moss stitch

Row 1 (rs): Using B knit

Row 2 (ws): Using B knit

Row 3: Using A: K1, S1, K2, s1, *K4, s1, k2, s1; rep from * to last st; k1

Row 4: Using A: p1, s1, p2, s1, *p4, s1, p2, s1; rep from * to last st; p1

Row 5: Using B: knit

Row 6: Using B: k1, kw, k2, kw, *k4, kw, k2, kw; rep from * to last st, k1

Row 7: Using A: K1, s1, k2, s1, *k4, s1, k2, s1, rep from * to last st, k1

Row 8: as row 4

Row 9: as row 3

Row 10: as row 4

Repeat these ten rows sixty times, for a total of 61 repeats.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 once

Using A, finish with three rows moss stitch

Bind off

Finishing:

Weave in ends; block
