



May is for Ari

Size:

One

Finished Measurements:

4 inches x 70 inches

Materials:

One ball of Lorna's Laces Shepherd Sock in the color of your choice (shown in Berry)

Size US #2 needles

Pattern Notes:

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2tog: Knit two together

SSK: slip one, slip one, knit the two together

C2L: slip one stitch to DPN, hold to front of work; knit one, knit one from DPN

C2R: slip one stitch to DPN, hold to back of work; knit one, knit one from DPN

C3R: slip two stitches to DPN, hold to back of work; knit one, knit two from DPN

S1-k1tog-ssso: Slip one, knit one, pass the slipped stitch over

I have to admit that my scarf curled much more than I thought it would, even after blocking. If you would like to compensate for this, cast on 37, and change the side edges from a K2 border to a K5 border.

Instructions:

Cast on 31

Knit one row

Row 1: K5, [k2tog, yo, k1, yo, s1-k1-ssso, k3] three times, k2

Row 2 and all even numbered rows: K2, p29, k2

Row 3: K4, C2R, k3, C2L, [k1, C2R, k3, C2L] twice, k4

Row 5: K3, C2R, k5, [c3r, k5] twice, C2L, k3

Row 7: K4, yo, s1-k1-ssso, k3, k2tog, yo, [k1, yo, s1-k1-ssso, k3, k2tog, yo] twice, k4

Row 9: K5, [C2L, k1, C2R, k3] three times, k2

Row 11: K6, c3r, [k5, c3r] twice, k6

Row 12: as row 2

Repeat these twelve rows thirty-nine times, for a total of forty repeats. On the last repeat, substitute a row of knitting for the last "Row 12". Knit one more row, and bind off.

Finishing:

Weave in ends; block
