



# October is for Spinners

Arachne, the original spinner, is portrayed here in a twisted stitch pattern from Barbara Walker's Third Treasury of Knitting Patterns (The chart can be found on page 35 if you are more comfortable with boxes than you are with words.). The scarf begins on size 6 US needles using four stands of lace weight yarn held together. While the scarf progresses threads are dropped and the needle size is increased as the consistency of our spinner's web is interrupted by neglect and disrepair.

*Finished Measurements:* 10"x53" sans fringe. I had 35g of yarn left over from the skein, so make it longer if you like.

*Materials:* One skein of Prism Lace Wool yarn (100g, 1460yds), size 6 US needles, size 8 US needles, size 10½ US needles, size 13 US needles, safety pin or piece of waste yarn, blocking wires.

## *Definitions used in this pattern:*

**K** = Knit

**P** = Purl

**Seed Stitch** = Over an odd number of stitches, \*K1, P1 (Repeat from \* until one stitch remains), K1

**K1-b** = Knit through the back loop

**RT** = Right Twist – Knit two together, leaving the stitch on the left needle. Insert the right needle between the stitches just knitted together, and knit the first stitch again. Slip both stitches together off the left needle.

**LT** = Left Twist – Skip one stitch and knit the second stitch through the back loop. Then knit both stitches together through the back loop.

**Cluster** = With yarn held in front, slip the given number of stitches to the right needle. Pass the yarn to the back and slip the same number of stitches back to the left needle. Pass the yarn to the front and purl the stitches.

**M1** = Make One – Lift the running thread between the stitch just worked and the next stitch. Knit into the back of this picked up thread.

**PRT** = Purl Right Twist – Skip one stitch and purl the second stitch. Then purl the skipped stitch. Slip both stitches together from the left needle.

**PLT** = Purl Left Twist – Skip one stitch and purl the second stitch through the back loop. Then purl the skipped stitch through the front loop. Slip both stitches together from the left needle.

**SSK** = Slip Slip Knit – Slip next stitch to the right needle knit-wise. Slip the second stitch to the right needle knit-wise. Place the left needle into the front of both stitches and knit them together.

**K2tog** = Knit Two Together – Place the right needles into the next two stitches as if to knit. Knit them together.

**K3tog** = Knit Three Together – Place the right needles into the next three stitches as if to knit. Knit them all together.

**YO** = Yarn Over – Wrap the yarn around the right needle in a counter-clockwise direction to increase the stitch count by one.

**YO2** = Yarn Over Twice – Wrap the yarn around the right needle twice in a counter-clockwise direction to increase the stitch count by two.

**P2tog** = Purl Two Together – Place the right needles into the next two stitches as if to purl. Purl them together.

*Instructions:*

Using size US6 needles and four strands of yarn held together, cast on 49 stitches.

Rows 1-5 - \*K1, P1 (Repeat from \* until one stitch remains), K1

Row 6 (Public side) - K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P3, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1

Maintain the five stitch seed stitch border on each end of the scarf, while inserting the following between the borders:

Row 7 –K16, P1, K5, P1, K16

Row 8 –P16, K1-b, P5, K1-b, P16

Row 9 –K16, P1, K5, P1, K16

Row 10 –P16, K1-b, P5, K1-b, P16

Row 11 –K9, P1, K6, P1, K5, P1, K6, P1, K9

Row 12 – P9, K1-b, P5, RT, P5, LT, P5, K1-b, P9

Row 13 – K9, P1, K5, P1, K7, P1, K5, P1, K9

Row 14 –P9, K1-b, P4, RT, P7, LT, P4, K1-b, P9

Row 15 –K9, P1, K4, P1, K9, P1, K4, P1, K9

Row 16 –P8, RT, P3, RT, P9, LT, P3, LT, P8

Row 17 –K8, P1, K4, P1, K11, P1, K4, P1, K8

Row 18 –P7, RT, P3, RT, P11, LT, P3, LT, P7

Row 19 –K7, P1, K4, P1, K5, Cluster 3, K5, P1, K4, P1, K7

Row 21 –K7, P1, K4, P1, K5, P2, (P1, YO, P1) in next stitch, P2, K5, P1, K4, P1, K7

Row 22 –P7, LT, P3, LT, P4, K1, M1, K2, K1-b, K2, M1, K1, P4, RT, P3, RT, P7

Row 23 –K8, (P1, K4) twice, P9, (K4, P1) twice, K8

Row 24 –P5, (P3, LT) twice, P3, K9, P3, (RT, P3) twice, P5

Row 25 –K9, PRT, K3, P1, K3, P9, K3, P1, K3, PLT, K9

Row 26 –P10, (LT, P2) twice, K9, (P2, RT) twice, P10

Row 27 –K11, PRT, K2, P1, K2, P9, K2, P1, K2, PLT, K11

Row 28 –P12, (LT, P1) twice, SSK, K5, K2tog, (P1, RT) twice, P12

Row 29 – K13, PRT, K1, P1, K1, P7, K1, P1, K1, PLT, K13

Row 30 –P14, LT twice, SSK, K3, K2tog, RT twice, P14

Row 31 –K15, PRT, P1, Cluster 5, P1, PLT, K15

Row 32 –P16, LT, K5, RT, P16

Row 33 – K17, P7, K17

Row 34 –P17, RT, K3, LT, P17

Row 35 –K16, PLT, P5, PRT, K16

Row 36 – P15, RT twice, K3, LT twice, P15

Row 37 –K14, PLT, K1, P1, K1, P3, K1, P1, K1, PRT, K14

Row 38 –P13, (RT, P1) twice, (K1, YO) twice, K1, (P1, LT) twice, P13

Row 39 –K12, PLT, K2, P1, K2, P5, K2, P1, K2, PRT, K12

Row 40 –P11, RT, P2, RT, P1, K1, SSK, K3tog, Pass SSK stitch over the K3tog, K1, P1, LT, P2, LT, P11

Row 41 –K10, PLT, K3, P1, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P1, K3, PRT, K10

Row 42 –P9, RT, P3, (RT, P1) twice, LT, P1, LT, P3, LT, P9

Row 43 –K9, P1, K4, P1, K2, P1, K3, P1, K2, P1, K4, P1, K9

Row 44 –P5, (P3, RT) twice, P9, (LT, P3) twice, P5

Row 120 – K10, K2tog, K5, YO, K2tog, Drop 2 YO, YO2, K2, Drop YO, K1, YO, K1, Drop 2 YO, K1, YO2, K2tog, Drop YO, K1, K2tog, K2, YO, K2tog, K1, P2

Row 121 – K2, P1, P2tog, P3, YO, P1, YO2, P1, Drop 2 YO, YO2, P3, P2tog, YO, P1, Drop 2YO, YO2, P18

Row 132 – K16, SSK, YO, K2, K2tog, YO, K4, Drop 2YO, 2YO, K2, YO, K2tog, K7

Row 133 – P8, YO, P2tog, P2, Drop YO, P2tog, P4, YO, P1, YO, P19

Row 135 – P15, YO, P2tog, P6, Drop 2YO, P1, Drop YO, P16

Row 146 – K9, Drop next stitch and let it unravel down to the YO, K8, K2tog, Drop YO, K1, Drop YO, K2, K2tog, K9

Row 147 – P8, YO2, P1, YO, P1, YO, P12, YO2, P2tog, P7

Row 148 – K8, K1 into the YO, K1 into the second YO (This is kind of fiddley, and it won't ever make a *real* stitch, but it keeps the run in the fabric nice and wide.), K11, YO2, K1, Drop YO, K1, Drop YO, YO2, K1, Drop 2YO, K8

Row 149 – P7, YO, P2, Drop 2YO, YO, P1, YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P10, YO2, P11

Row 150 – K7, Drop next stitch and allow it to unravel (It will unravel to a K2tog stitch a few rows down. After that stitch splits in two, allow the right stitch to unravel to the YO. Place the left stitch on a safety pin or piece of waste yarn until after you have blocked the scarf.), K1, Drop YO, K1, Drop 2YO, 2YO, K9, K2tog, Drop YO, YO2, K1, Drop YO, K1, YO, K1, Drop YO, K2, YO2, K5

Row 151 – P5, Drop 2YO, YO3, P2tog, P1, Drop YO, P1, YO, P1, Drop 2YO, YO, P8, P2tog, Drop 2YO, YO, P9

Row 152 – K7, SSK, K12, Drop YO, YO2, K2, YO, K1, Drop 3YO, YO2, K1, YO, SSK, K2

Row 153 – P3, Drop YO, P1, Drop 2YO, YO, P1, Drop YO, P1, YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P11, YO, P9

Row 154 – K7, YO, K3, SSK, K9, YO2, K1, Drop YO, K1, YO, K1, Drop YO, K2, YO, SSK, YO

Row 155 – Drop YO, YO, P1, Drop YO, P2tog, YO2, P4, Drop 2YO, YO, P6, YO, P2tog, P13

Row 156 – K9, YO, K1, YO, K4, Drop YO, YO2, K6, Drop YO, K2, YO2, K2, Drop 2YO, YO, K1, YO, K2

**Switch to size 8 needles**

Row 157 – P2, Drop YO, YO2, P1, Drop YO, P1, YO, P1, Drop 2YO, YO, P2tog, P6, Drop 2YO, YO, P2tog, P2, Drop YO, P1, YO, P2tog, P8

Row 158 – K11, YO, K1, YO2, K1, YO, K11, Drop YO, K1, YO, K1, Drop 2YO, YO, K2, YO

Row 159 – P3, Drop YO, P1, YO, P13, Drop YO, P1, Drop 2YO, YO, P2, P2tog, P9

Row 160 – K11, YO, K1, Drop YO, YO, K14, Drop YO, K1, YO, K2, YO, K1

Row 161 – P2, YO, P1, YO, P1, Drop YO, P16, YO, P1, Drop YO, P11

Row 162 – K13, YO, K2tog, K16, K2tog, K1, YO, K1

Row 163 – P2, P2tog, P18, P2tog, P11

Row 164 – K11, SSK, K2tog, K18

Row 165 – Purl

Row 166 – SSK, K27, K2tog

Row 167-174 – Continue in stockinette stitch

Row 191 – K7, YO, K2, YO3, K1, YO2, K8, Drop next stitch and let it unravel down to the YO, K7

Row 192 – P15, Drop 2YO, P1, Drop 3YO, P2, Drop YO, P7

Row 193 – K7, YO2, K1, YO3, K2, YO, K15

Row 194 – P15, Drop YO, P2, Drop 3YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P3, Break off one strand of yarn so that you are now knitting with 2 strands held together, P4

Row 195 – K6, YO2, K1, YO3, K2, YO, K6, YO, K10

Row 196 – P20, Drop 3YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P6

Row 197 – K6, YO2, K1, YO3, K1, YO2, K19

Row 198 – P19, Drop 2YO, P1, Drop 3YO, P9

Row 199 – K6, Drop 2YO, YO2, K2, YO2, K1, Drop next stitch and let it unravel down to the YO, K17

Row 200 – P18, Drop 2YO, P2, Drop 2YO, P6

Row 201 – K3, YO, K2, YO2, K1, YO3, K2, YO2, K5, K2tog, Drop next stitch and let it unravel down to the YO, YO, K10

Row 202 – P17, Drop 2YO, P2, Drop 3YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P6

Row 203 – K6, YO2, K1, YO3, K2, YO2, K2, YO, K15

Row 204 – P15, Drop YO, P2, Drop 2YO, P2, Drop 3YO, P1, Drop 2YO, P6

Using a sewn bind off, bind off very, very loosely. Knot the end instead of weaving it in, and leave a 5" tail.

Break off (Do not cut.) 7 pieces of yarn 6-12 inches long and attach them halfhazardly as fringes at the bind off end of the scarf.

Cut lengths of yarn 13" long and create a fringe at the cast on end of the scarf. Make 9 groups of fringes, each containing 11 strands of yarn. Trim this fringe so that it is very neat and even.

Using blocking wires, spray block the scarf. When dry, remove the safety pin or waste yarn that holds the loose stitch on row 150.

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
