

# September is for Antony

## Size:

One

## Finished Measurements:

5 ½" by 71", stretched and blocked

## Materials:

Two skeins of Lorna's Laces Organic Wool Worsted

## Pattern Notes:

This pattern could easily be adapted into a wider scarf by adding to the cast-on number in multiples of 6

C4b: slip 2 sts to DPN and hold in back; k2, k2 from DPN

C4f: slip 2 sts to DPN and hold in front; k2, k2 from DPN

BC: slip 1 to DPN and hold in back, k2, p the st from DPN

FC: slip 2 to DPN and hold in front, p1, k the sts from DPN

The instructions located within brackets [such as this] are for the moss stitch border; they are separated to make it easily discernable from the cable pattern. If it helps you as you're knitting, consider placing a marker after the first three and before the last three stitches.



## Instructions:

Cast on 44

Set up rows:

\*K1, P1; repeat to end of row

\*P1, K1; repeat to end of row

\*K1, P1; repeat to end of row

**1 (ws)** [P1, k1, p1] K2, \*p4, k2; rep from \* [K1, p1, k1]

**2 (rs)** [K1, p1, k1] P2, \*C4b, p2; rep from \* [P1, k1, p1]

**3** as row 1

**4** [K1, p1, k1] P1, \*BC, FC; rep from \*, end p1 [P1, k1, p1]

**5** [P1, k1, p1] K1, p2, \*k2, p4; rep from \*, end w/p2, k1 [K1, p1, k1]

**6** [K1, p1, k1] P1, k2, p2, C4f, p2; rep from \*, end w/k2, p1 [P1, k1, p1]

**7** as row 5

**8** [K1, p1, k1] P1, \*FC, BC; rep from \*, end p1 [P1, k1, p1]

Repeat the above eight rows 44 more times, for a total of 45 repeats

Last three rows:

\*P1, K1; repeat to end of row

\*K1, P1; repeat to end of row

\*P1, K1; repeat to end of row

Bind off

## Finishing:

Weave in ends; block if necessary
